## How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
  - Instructional strategies
  - Professional learning
  - School structures and processes for learning
  - Resources to improve student learning
  - Data-informed decision making



# School Development Plan – School Goal

- **Our 2025–2026 Goals**
- **Strengthen Student Writing** (organization, vocabulary, feedback)
- **Build Resilience – Brave Like a Buffalo** (social awareness & relationships)
- **Deepen Truth & Reconciliation Learning** (Treaty 7, land, Indigenous perspectives)



# School Development Plan – Outcome

## Outcomes We Expect to See

- Stronger writing organization and vocabulary
- Increased student writing confidence
- Students demonstrating resilience and relationship skills
- Improved student engagement
- Deeper understanding of Indigenous perspectives and Treaty 7





# School Development Plan – Outcome Measures

## How We Will Measure Progress

- Writing prompt growth (Spring 2025 → Spring 2026)
- Student confidence & engagement survey data
- Attendance trends
- Assurance Survey results
- Classroom evidence & student work samples



# School Development Plan – Data for Monitoring Progress



## Data We Monitor Throughout the Year

- Writing prompt growth (Fall → Spring)
- Literacy screening data (LeNS, PAST, CC3, RAN)
- Student engagement & belonging surveys
- Attendance trends
- Classroom walkthrough evidence. “Look Fors”
- Student voice & reflection data

# School Development Plan – Actions

## School Development Plan – Key Actions for Students

- Strengthen student writing (organization, vocabulary, feedback)
- Provide targeted early literacy support using screening data
- Teach resilience and relationship skills through *Brave Like a Buffalo*
- Increase student voice and engagement in learning
- Deepen understanding of Indigenous perspectives and Treaty 7



# School Development Plan – Actions

## School Development Plan – How We Support This Work

- Ongoing teacher professional learning aligned to SDP priorities
- Monthly data review through Collaborative Response Model (CRM)
- Classroom walkthroughs aligned to writing, SEL, and Indigenous learning
- Strategic use of budget to support literacy, well-being, and inclusion

## Our School Budget

- Our school received just over a million dollars in 2025-26 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers **staffing** and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational **supplies**.

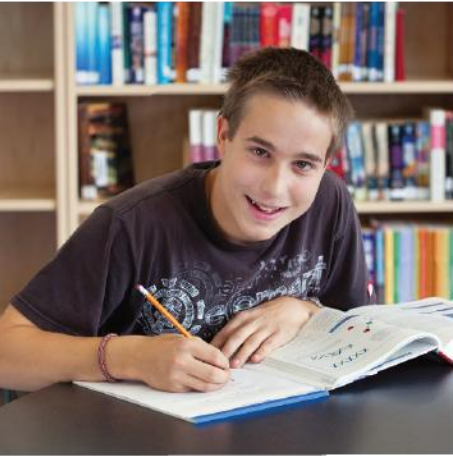
